## Weiterbildungsangebote, Wissens- und Technologietransfer für Asien

Asiatische Studenten an Berliner Hochschulen gehören heute zum alltäglichen Bild. Viele von ihnen studieren hier, um das Wissen aus Berlin später in ihren Heimatländern anzuwenden. ## Offers of Further Education, Knowledge and Technology Transfer for Asia

Today, Asian students at Berlin universities are common and belong to the daily picture. Many of them study here in order to later apply their knowledge gained in Berlin, in their home countries. However, this is not the only form of the transfer of knowledge and technology from the German capital to Asia. Beyond that, the universities intensively deal with the economical and technological developments in Asia, they offer international courses of studies, and together with Asian partners they run educational offers and technology projects. Besides interesting lectures which present examples of the intercontinental cooperation the four universities which arranged the program together, offer the visitors a market which parallelly takes place, providing a lot of information and the possibility of asking questions to the universities.
